

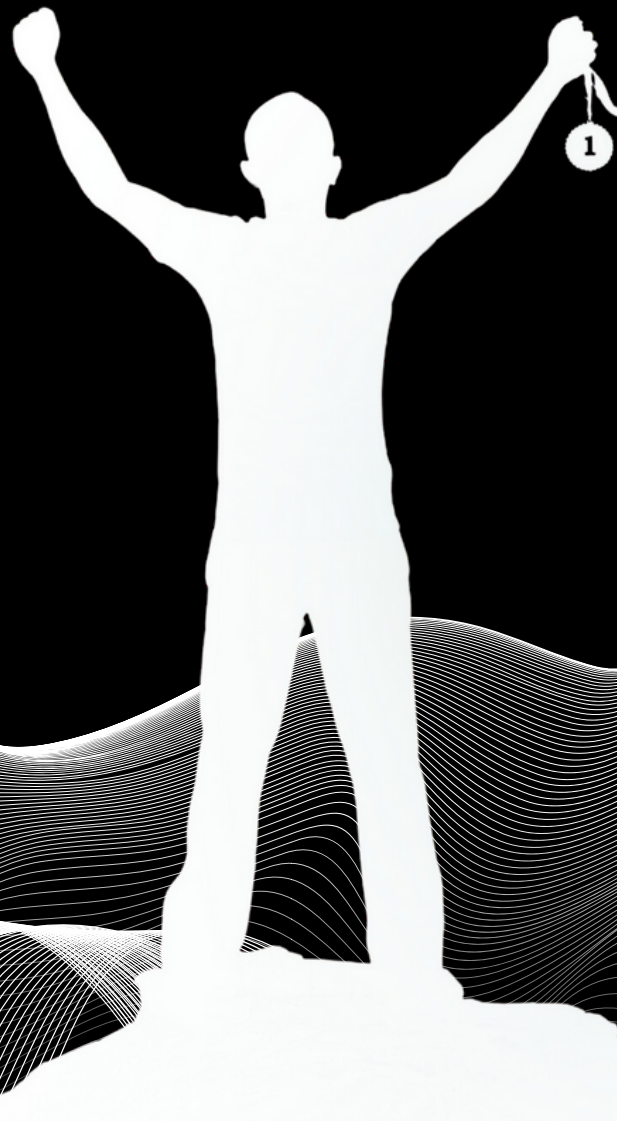

The Power of Self-Compassion

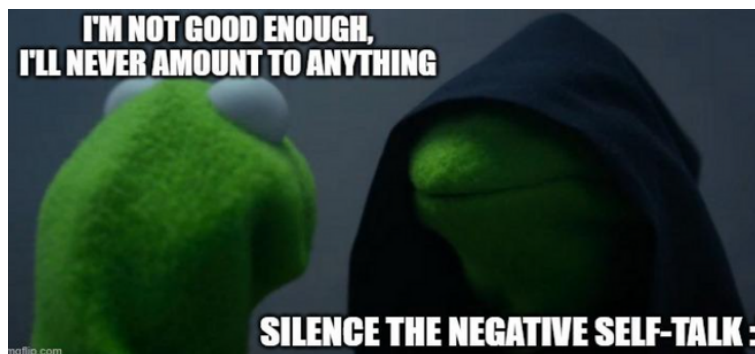
